

# THE VIEW



**SPECIFIC VIEWS:** Highlight specific views to the Memorial Church and in the distance, Cape Blomidon.

**PANORAMA:** Position the observer to continuously see the panorama from different viewpoints.

- to respond to the unique nature and location of the site and the surrounding historical community
- to create a place that balances the interests of the visitor with the local residents
- to provide opportunities to use the place throughout the seasons
- to produce a plan that is sustainable in terms of long-term maintenance costs
- to make the least possible encroachment on the existing landscape
- to make the space accessible

# THE LANDSCAPE

**LANDSCAPE PATTERNS:** Plot division reflecting dykeland and land allotments, and settlement patterns.



**STEWARDSHIP:** Provide opportunities to learn about those who have been stewards of dykes and dykeland.

**NATURALIZE:** Prepare a low maintenance, natural plan containing native plants that can be allowed to grow and be mown annually.



# THE PEOPLE



**NATURAL PLAY AREA:** Provide opportunities for children to play and learn about the nature of the site.

**PEDESTRIAN TRAIL:** Link and connect to local area's amenities and features, and provide opportunity for movement through site and down to the Grand Pre Historic Site.



**HARVEST:** Celebrate the long-standing local economy of food, and provide opportunity for communal picnics.
